

The Learning and Outcomes Committee

Terms of Reference

Membership	The committee shall consist of one member of the Senior Leadership Team and as a minimum three other governors. With the agreement of the committee, additional governors may attend meetings as associate members without voting rights. Other staff may be invited to attend in an advisory capacity.
Chair	The chair will be appointed by the committee annually.
Clerk	Minutes will be produced by the clerk to the committee and reported back to the governing body.
Quorum	Any three members not disqualified by having an interest requiring them to withdraw.
Meetings	The committee will meet at least three times per school year. An agenda will be agreed by the committee chair and circulated seven days prior to the meeting.

Terms of Reference

- 1 To review all aspects of Learning and Outcomes as required and make recommendations for the SIP.
- 2 Review the following specific sections of the SIP:
 - Quality of Teaching, Learning and Assessment
 - Outcomes for Pupils
 - Early Years Provision
- 3 To evaluate school performance using performance data (eg. ASP, Teacher assessments and test results) concerning pupil progress and attainment. Probe attainment and identify areas for improvement. Escalate issues of under-performance and / or opportunities to further improve school performance to the Full Governors' meeting, and provide insight about school performance to the lead Governor for Headteacher Performance Management where appropriate.
- 4 To liaise and consult with other committees as appropriate.
