As you know, Thrapston Primary School received a remote monitoring inspection by Ofsted on 3rd and 4th February to consider whether or not leaders and those responsible for governance are taking effective action to provide education in the current circumstances. The inspection was carried out by two of Her Majesty's Inspectors (HMI).

We are now able to share the findings of this inspection and we are extremely pleased to report that the HMIs concluded that we **are** taking effective action and their findings were incredibly positive, reflecting the hard work of the school and community.

The letter that we have received captures the main headlines of the visit and there are some key feedback points that we would like to share with you:

- All pupils are able to access education either in school or at home via electronic devices.
- Senior leaders have worked hard to ensure pupils have the necessary resources.
- The school continues to prioritise the safety and wellbeing of staff and children.
- The school has ensured that teachers continue to provide phonics lessons every day and they have supported children with reading at home.
- The SENCo is knowledgeable and ensures that SEND children are well supported both at home and in school.
- Senior leaders have worked hard to support staff and parents in delivering the curriculum for all children.
- Governors have supported school leaders in their delivery of the curriculum.

Finally, we would like to thank all those who were able to respond to the Parent View survey. The inspection team commented on the amount of free text that parents wrote and the overwhelmingly positive comments that parents took the time to write.
