

Parent Survey March 2021 – Return to school after Lockdown.

Survey was open from 22nd to 26th March 2021 – third full week after return to school.

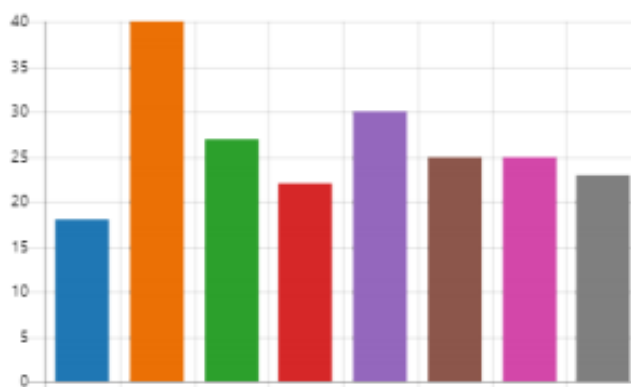
- There were 210 responses.
- 98% of parents were satisfied or very satisfied with the communication about the return to school.
- 13% of parents had concerns about the return to school in advance; 99% are satisfied or very satisfied about the support they have been given since the return.
- 21% of children were worried in advance about the return to school; this reduced to 6% post return to school.

Q7 - Is there anything further you feel the school could do to support your child?

69 Comments were made (appendix 1) – in the main these were very positive. Others were based on:

- general comments about knowing where their child is possibly through online parents evenings or telephone calls.
- Which day are spelling tests?
- is the school day the correct length of time whilst we have staggered timings due to Covid?
- check given name with name child chooses to go by.
- Suggestions to include more teaching about emotions, use of social media and also scientific developments into our curriculum.

Q8 - Are there any other comments you would like to make?

78 Responses made (appendix 2) – again vast majority were extremely positive and referred to specific groups of staff or individuals. Other comments included:

- concerns about parents not social distancing
- issues about transition between year groups
- query about need for testing (Covid)
