

Children sort coins into pence: *1p, 2p, 5p, 10p, 20p, 50p* and pounds: *£1, £2, £5, £10, £20*.



Children sort the coins correctly in other ways.

*Daniel has 5p in his left hand – this is the smallest coin in size. It is not the coin with the lowest value, as this would be 1p. Daniel has £2 in his right hand – this is the largest coin and the coin with the highest value.*



*The girl could have a 1p or 2p, and a £2 coin.*

*The boy has a £5 note. He also has a 5p and a 10p.*
