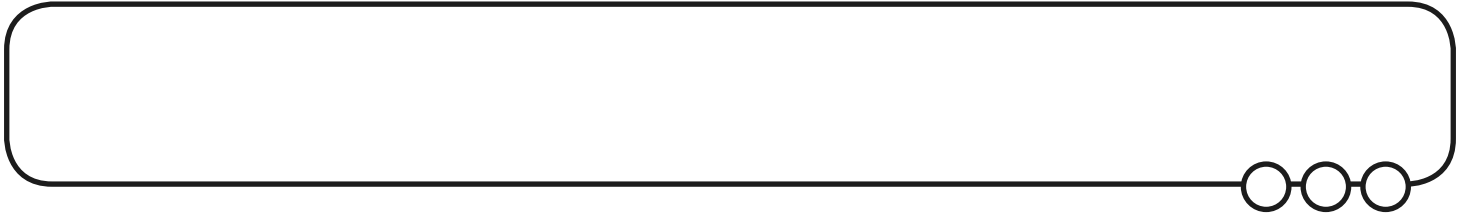
Remember - If the root word ends in y with a consonant letter before it, the y is changed to i, but only if the root word has more than one syllable.
