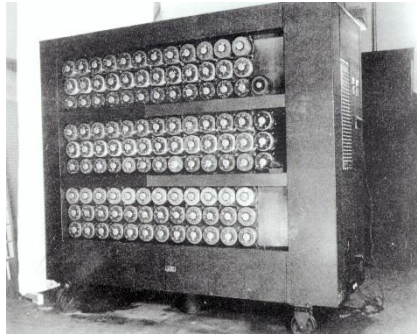


Summer Holiday Homework – Year 6
